WAYNE-WESTLAND COMMUNITY SCHOOLS PARKING REGULATIONS

RULES REGARDING STUDENT DRIVING AND PARKING:

1. All vehicles parked on the school grounds must be registered with the school.
2. Registered vehicles must have the current parking sticker permanently applied to the rear window on the passenger side. If application to the rear window is not possible, sticker should be applied to the front passenger side windshield. (Permission must be given by administration if this is the case.)
3. Parking is strictly limited to the student parking areas. Students may not park in lots designated as "Authorized School Personnel Only", "Faculty Parking", or "Visitor Parking".
4. All student drivers must be licensed and covered by insurance. The school assumes no responsibility for lost or stolen items or vehicles nor any damage that may occur while parked at John Glenn. Driving and parking is at your own risk.
5. There is to be no loitering in the parking lot or visitation of a parking lot without permission of the school.
6. If in the opinion of school officials a student is driving in excess of 15 miles per hour or is driving in a careless, reckless or unsafe manner, driving privileges can be revoked and disciplinary action may result.
7. Student drivers who register to park on school property and who are given permission to do so are deemed to have consented to search of their vehicles by school authorities, when building administrators reasonably suspect that drugs, alcohol, weapons, stolen property or other contraband may be present in their vehicle.
8. It is considered a privilege to park on school grounds. Parking regulations are strictly enforced. Students in violation of these rules are subject to discipline suspension, loss of driving privileges and/or vehicle ticketing/towing by the Westland Police. Warning notices may also be adhered to vehicles that are not displaying a JGHS parking permit.
9. Student drivers and passengers should wear seat belts. It's the law!
